Originally, I wanted to create something to do with the 4 elements and how they could be interpreted through doncing. However, I ended up tossing that idea cuz I felt I didn't have a good concept built around it.

However, I the thought of something that was backed up by a conesive idea. My plan is to help dancers interpret the 3 states of matter through motion capture and with the use of VFX to create a more realistic illusion.

But why? As human beings we are used to interpreting sound with emotions, colours, gustures, mousments, etc. But those can only take us so far... In the end, we are still limited by our realities, bodies and owrall the characteristics of the things around us. For example, when listening to "Spring by Vivaldi, it really gives us the illusion of sunny weather, birds singing, a grass field, flowers. It also invokes serenity, happiness and with it the urge to move accordingily. On the other hand, when listening to each of the other seasons, you get a computely different feeling. The movements to describe each piece are opposites and communicate ideas tipically associated with each season. This shows how we tend to associate certain movements to contain sounds. But this can also happen with colours, shapes, states. However, they are simply nutaphovical/ideological connections our broins create. There are no birds or flowers, there is no green and dancing graciously does not turn us into spring. My idea is to change this! If I give dancers the ability to physically change their appearance, surrondings and/or properties, we can get a step causer to visualising those imaginary ideas with the help of special effects. If a dancer wants to dance like water, I can transform thom into water and really create the feeling of a fluid, not only throught movement, but also through visuals.

Therefore I come up with the idea of the 3 states of matter. But again, why these specifically? Because we are solid beings at least on the outside. Therefore, our experiences are limited to the physical properties of such state. But what if we could embody other States? We could not only capture the essence through movement but also by recreating the actual appearance of a gas, for example.

My idea is to let dancers interpret a song by using movements they associate with each state of matter. Then I will take it further by giving them the physical/visual properties of that state, and creating an interpretation of matter that goes beyond our human capabilities.

*Dancing relies on being solid and therefore is a physical limitation we cannol overcome.
